Who Can Join? <u>Families Who</u>:

- 1. Make a **season long commitment** to the teams, coaches, and the other Thunder families.
- 2. Volunteer during games and other events, as needed.
- 3. Have players who are at least **51% homeschooled** and meet the **NCHC** <u>Guidelines</u>.
- 4. Have not left another homeschool organization or school for **disciplinary reasons** in the last 12 months.
- 5. Are willing to abide by and sign our <u>Code of Conduct</u> and <u>Grievance Policy</u>.

Eligibility

- 51% Homeschool Requirement
- 2.0 GPA (on a 4 point scale)
- Homeschool transfers: Eligible Immediately if transferring from a NCHC Participant*, or Homeschooled for two consecutive years, and not leaving for disciplinary reasons. (Upperclassman)
- Upperclassmen transfers from Public/Private school must file hardship with NCHBC:

Grievance Policy

The athlete and/or parent should discuss the concern with the coach and work to a mutually agreeable solution. Until a coach is made aware of an issue, nothing can be done to alleviate it. Athletes and parents are to request a meeting with the coach at a mutually agreed-upon time. <u>Never approach a coach before/during/after a practice or game to discuss conflicts</u> unless the conversation has been prearranged.

Sick Policy

In consideration of all Dallas Thunder families, during times of illness, we ask that parents or players refrain from attending Dallas Thunder games or practices on a day that he or she is experiencing any of the following symptoms, unrelated to any ongoing physical issues or allergies, within the last 24 hours:

- Fever
- Cough (non-allergy related)
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Contagious illness such as, but not limited to, pink eye, chicken pox, measles, mumps, rubella, strep throat
- If anyone in your family is diagnosed with the flu, please keep everyone home for **24 hours after** all symptoms clear.

Background Check Policy

All Caretakers of players and the Dallas Thunder Board and Basketball Committee are subject to a criminal background check. Caretakers include coaches and assistant coaches, **including parent volunteer coaches**. Upon completing a background check, the following is a list of automatic disqualifiers. Other reasons to disqualify a candidate are at discretion of the Dallas Thunder Basketball Committee.

Automatic disqualifiers:

- 1. The volunteer refuses to complete the screening process
- 2. Sex offenses and misconduct
- 3. Violent felonies
- 4. Felonies (other than sex or violence related) within the past 10 years
- 5. Any child abuse or domestic violence convictions
- 6. Misdemeanors within the past seven years excluding traffic violations

Additionally, pending convictions and/or arrests for the above items will be considered as a disqualifier.

Refund Policy

If a family notifies the organization of player withdrawal within one day of the Parent-Coach Meeting and upon return in good condition of the practice jersey, **the organization will retain Tuition and Fees equal to 10% of the full-season** and refund the balance of previously paid Tuition and Fees.

If a family notifies the organization of a player withdrawal more than one day after the parent coaches meeting, we retain 100% of the **Tuition and Fees**. If the circumstances are beyond the control of the family, then we will consider refunds on an ad hoc basis.

Abandonment Policy

Abandonment is when a player leaves a team during the season. The season is defined as the day after the parent-coach meeting through the day of the last game of the season. The purpose of this policy is to encourage players to consider the team before themselves, to emphasize the importance of continuity for a team, and to encourage our families not to quit, but to work out differences per the Grievance Policy.

If a player abandons the team during the season by preference (for example the player wants another coach, different playing time, or to play for a different organization) then the player will not be considered for registration until after the next full season, and will only be accepted upon approval by vote of the Dallas Thunder Leadership Team.

If a player leaves the organization before or after the season, then this is not considered abandonment. The player is permitted to re-apply the next season per normal registration protocol.

If a player leaves the team because of a higher priority than basketball (1. God, 2. Family, 3. School) and has NOT broken any policies, then this is not considered abandonment. The player is permitted to re-apply the next season per normal registration protocol.



- Monthly payments due at the 1st practice of the month (Sept, Oct, Nov): must pay to practice/play.
- Other costs to consider Uniforms, fuel for traveling to games, admission into some games (some schools and Thunder charge an entry fee), eating out (many games are around dinner time), tournament shirts, travel, hotel and food cost for nationals and possibly regional/district, spirit wear, nationals spirit bucket, extra team tournaments, and uniform replacements or custom orders.
- Payment plans are available.

Financial Agreement

This Financial Responsibility Agreement document includes a promise, from / by each family, to pay the tuition and fundraising that is required.

- 1. Tuition (or the first tuition payment) (tuition / 3) must be paid by 9/4 to start practicing.
- 2. Tuition (or the second tuition payment) must be paid by the first practice in October to continue practicing.
- 3. Tuition (or the final tuition payment) must be paid by the first practice in November to continue practicing and the fundraising amount is due within 2 weeks after the BIG Serve. As of the first November practice, any non-payment means no practicing or playing in games until payment received.

Players will not be allowed to practice if their payment has not been received.

Scholarship Request

- Dallas Thunder has created a \$1,000.00 scholarship fund. We will accept donations to help increase this amount.
- Scholarship help will be distributed to families based on applications and need.
- Scholarships will be given after the second week of practice.

Uniforms

- Uniform sizing day will be during practice on Sept. 18th
- Returning players will be required to wear white uniform for inspection.
- Leadership will inspect all player uniforms, and families are responsible for replacements and repairs, as needed.
- New players this season will purchase their uniform.

Players will need to purchase a royal blue/white reversible practice jersey for all practices.

Uniforms - Price

- Uniforms are approximately \$180.00 + shipping.
- Individual pieces can be purchased as needed.
- Seniors or players who leave the organization at the end of the season can sell uniforms to new players next year or keep the uniforms.
